


ABOUT THE EVENT

Despite its potential, the state faces challenges in terms of poverty, education, and infrastructure development, but recent efforts in improving governance and promoting investment are helping to stimulate growth and development.

Rewa

Rewa, often referred to as the "Land of White Tigers," is a captivating city in Madhya Pradesh that beautifully combines historical heritage with natural beauty.
